Project scope:

Concrete and General Trades work on 6 building additions totaling 132,800 sq. ft. and renovation of 5,600 sq. ft. in existing locker room facility. Work included

- placing and grading 6,600 ton of 304 stone
- excavating, forming and placing 2,300 LF of 4' high grade wall
- placing and finishing 138,400 sq. ft. of concrete slabs
- installing 114 tons of reinforcing steel
- installing 200 LF of concrete retaining wall, 6 ft. tall

Concrete package # 2 included constructing foundations, walls, pits and floor slabs for 2 new buildings and additions to 4 other buildings (200,000 TSF).
