Project scope:

This is a 32,000 square foot, metal building framed, Youth Impact Center. It features a Chapel, gymnasium, Workout Room, Family Fun Zone, and several offices and classrooms. The Chapel has a "State-of-the-Art" sound and lighting system. It offers something for youth of all ages in a colorful and unique setting.

Concrete strip footings, concrete foundation walls, metal stud wall framing, metal siding/brick veneer exterior walls, metal roof, concrete sidewalks, asphalt parking area, concrete slab on grade, metal studs, gypsum board, concrete block walls (gymnasium), paint, carpet (office), rubber floor (gymnasium, Kid's Fun Zone, Workout Room), sealed concrete floors in balance.
