Project scope:

Built in 1999, this is the newest building on campus. The \$13.5 Million facility opened on January 10, 2000 for classes. This is the humanities building, containing the English, Religion, Languages, East Asian Studies, History, Philosophy, Political Science, Women's Studies, and International Education / Study Abroad Departments. Hollenbeck has the only 24-hour a day computer lab on campus. Also located in this building are the Math Workshop, the Writing Center, and the Language computer lab. The 63,000-square-foot building is wired with the latest in information technology and contains 62 faculty offices, three computer labs and 22 classrooms, including one that seats 100. The building is named for donor Jane Hollenbeck, a Springfield resident and 1938 Wittenberg graduate.
