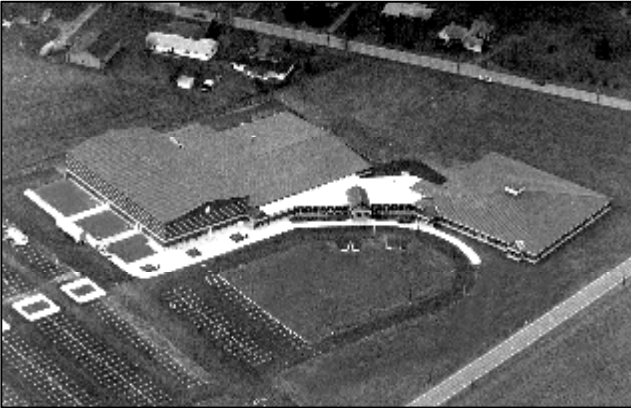

Project scope:

This facility consists of 100,000 square feet and is made of steel framing, masonry-bearing walls with split face block, and a multiple peaked metal roof and a cupola. The interior was built with durability and maintenance in mind with Terrazzo flooring. Bricks, normally used on the exterior, were utilized in the corridors. This facility is also wired for state-of-the-art technology.

Project accomplishments:

This project had a schedule that was set in stone, with no alternatives available. Tuttle responded by finishing the 70,000 square foot of classrooms and administrative areas within five (5) months. The balance of the building, the gymnasium and the cafeteria were finished in December. Overall, the project was completed on time and classes began as scheduled.
